DCA Hotel Policy

"Any exhibitor who allows his/her dogs to be loose and unattended in a room or to damage hotel property and does NOT immediately contact the hotel management to make proper restitution, will be subject to Show Committee action which could result in the loss of AKC privileges."

If it is determined by the Committee hearing that the rules are being neglected and destruction and/or misuse of property is taking place, the Committee has the authority to correct the problem or seek AKC suspension.

Additional Hotel Rules

- 1. Dogs left unattended in hotel rooms must be in crates.
- 2. Guests with dogs need to use designated entry/exit doors.
- Housekeeping must be allowed to clean a guest room (with dogs) at least every two days. Guests who have special requests can discuss them with the staff upon arrival.
- Bathing dogs in rooms is prohibited! Owners should bring their own toweling for bathing the dog at a designated area on the show grounds.
- 5. The individual guest will be responsible for any damage to a guest room or any hotel property. This includes, but is not limited to, replacement of carpets, if odors or stains cannot be removed with traditional cleaning methods. It would be wise to check your room before moving in for any pre-existing damage, and report it immediately to housekeeping or the front desk.
- 6. Dogs should be on leashes at all times when not in guest rooms.

- Dogs will not be allowed in designated areas or around the pool or restaurants.
- 8. The maximum number of dogs in a room is four (4).
- The hotel will remove the bedspreads from each room prior to check in. Extra blankets are available upon request.
